


YouTube API Guide


1.) Sign into a google account, and go to Google Developers Console here:

<https://console.developers.google.com>


2.) If you're a new user, **check** on the license agreement and click on “**accept**”



3.) Once inside, **click** the “**create**” button




4.) Use **Default Project Name** and click on “**create**”




Note: It's best to leave API Project names alone. You can give it a number for future reference but **Do Not** name them the same or something similar (like: MyTrafficJacker) to prevent possible issues.


5.) Click on “Enable APIs and Services”




6.) Scroll down until you see “YouTube Data API v3” and then click on it.



7.) Click on “Enable”



8.) Click on “create credential”




9.) Once your on the “add credential page”, **select** on the following:

Which API are you using = **“YouTube Data API v3”**

Where will you be calling the API from? = **“Other UI”**

What Data will you be accessing? = **“Public Data”**

After everything has been selected correctly, **click** on the button **“What credential do I need?”**

Which API are you using?
Different APIs use different auth platforms and some credentials can be restricted to only call certain APIs.

YouTube Data API v3

Where will you be calling the API from?
Credentials can be restricted using details of the context from which they're called. Some credentials are unsafe to use in certain contexts.

Other UI (e.g. Windows, CLI tool)

What data will you be accessing?
Different credentials are required to authorize access depending on the type of data that you request.


Public data
Access publicly available data provided by the API

User data
Access data belonging to a Google user, with their permission




10.) Right after, you'll be routed to a screen with your generated API credential. You'll need to **copy** your **API** from there and click on done.



11.) Once API key is created and copied, go to My Traffic Jacker then go to the “**YouTube API Key**” section and **hit** on the “**+**” button.



12.) Create an API Name and paste your copied API on the “Key Token” text box and click on “Add”


